

Evidence of Identity and Residency for Individuals - Documents Required

You will need to provide (your signature and date of birth must appear on at least one of the Category A or B documents):

- one Category A and two Category B documents, **or**
- one Category B and two Category A documents.

Evidence of Residential address is required if it is not provided on either of the Category A or B documents.

	Department of Immigration & Multicultural & Indigenous Affairs Certificate of Evidence of Resident Status (must be original)
	Australian Photographic Driver Licence (can be expired up to 2 years)
	Australian Defence Force Photo Identity Card (excluding civilians)
	Northern Territory Police & Fire Officer Photographic Identity Card
	NT Evidence of Age Card issued to customers established after 05 September 2005 (can be expired up to 2 years)
B Evidence of Use of Identity (Evidence of Existence in the Community)	Medicare Card, NT Pensioner and Carer Concession Card, Dept of Veterans Affairs Entitlement Card, NT Seniors Card
	Financial Institution Card with signature and embossed name
	Student Identity Document (with photo and/or signature) issued by an Educational Institution
	Department of Veteran Affairs / Centrelink Pensioner Concession Card
	Australian-issued Security Guard / Crowd Controller Licence (with photo)
	Australian-issued Firearm Licence (with photo)
	Overseas Photographic Driver Licence (in English or with official translation - can be expired up to 2 years)
	Approved NT Issued Identity Card (with photo), as follows – NT Government Employee ID Card NT Work Zone Traffic Management ID Card Tangentyere Council Proof of Identification Card
Evidence of Residential Address	Contract of purchase, current lease or rental document, receipt from an accommodation house or caravan park etc identifying the applicant and the residential address
	Formal NTG correspondence identifying applicant and residential address (dated within one year of the application)
	Formal Federal Government correspondence identifying residential address (dated within one year of the application)
	Council Rate Notice showing current residential address (not postal)
	Financial Institution document identifying applicant and residential address
	Utility or Services Account (Gas, Electricity, Water, Landline Telephone [not mobile], Austar, Broadband, Internet etc.) identifying the applicant and residential address
	Australian Taxation Office Assessment (Last or current financial year) showing current residential address (not postal) Please block out any reference to your Tax File Number
	Educational Institution document identifying the applicant and residential address
	Parental or Guardian Consent documentation (dated within one year of the application)
Evidence of Change of Name for an Individual (One of these documents plus full Evidence of Identity)	Marriage Certificate issued by the Registrar Births Deaths and Marriages (Commemorative certificates are not acceptable)
	Change of Name Registration with Births Deaths and Marriages
	Deed Poll (to prove name change) registered with relevant authority
	Divorce <i>Decree Nisi</i> or <i>Absolute</i> (indicating the name being reverted to)

All documents must be original (no photocopies) and unless otherwise stated must be current not expired. Documents not in English must be translated by either the Department of Immigration & Multicultural & Indigenous Affairs, or Interpreter and Translator Services NT (ITSNT) accredited translators.
