



Night Time and Wet Weather.



Hi children.
This week I want to remind you to...

Be seen at night and in wet weather.

It can be dangerous walking or riding your bike at night, or when it is raining.

When it gets dark, or it's raining, it is harder for you to see clearly. But remember, it is even harder for cars to see you!

To ride at night, your bike must have reflectors and lights that work well. A bright helmet also helps you to be seen more easily.


In wet weather, the surface of the road can be slippery so remember to walk or ride on the footpath and not on the road.




Things you can do to be seen more clearly:



1. Light, bright coloured  is easier to see.

2. Carry a  when you are walking. You can see where you are going and other people can see you.

3. Always cross the road near a streetlight and use a  where drivers can see you more easily.

4. If you are walking or riding in the rain, wear a brightly-coloured raincoat so drivers can see you.
